## PUPPY CHOW RECIPE



1. Warm up a few inches of water in a saucepan over low heat. Place a glass bowl over top of the saucepan, and add butter. Continue to stir the butter until it liquifies.
2. Using this same indirect heating method, add chocolate chips and brown sugar. Continue to stir the chocolate as it begins to melt, paying close attention to the melting process so you do not burn the chocolate. As soon as it melts, remove from the heat.
3. Drizzle the melted chocolate mixture over the Chex,<sup>TM</sup> using a wooden spoon to carefully coat the cereal.
4. Divide the coated cereal into large Ziploc<sup>®</sup> bags filled with crushed cookies, and shake until all of the cereal has been covered. Empty into a large serving bowl, and enjoy!

### INGREDIENTS

1 box Corn Chex<sup>TM</sup> cereal  
4 tbsp. butter  
1 c. chocolate chips  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  c. brown sugar  
 $1\frac{1}{2}$  c. chocolate chip cookies,  
crushed finely
