

THE BEST PAINT SHEEN

FOR EVERY SURFACE OF YOUR HOME

When selecting paint for your home, color is likely your first consideration, but the sheen of a paint is just as important. A paint's sheen is the amount of light it reflects, which can dramatically change how a color looks in your home. In addition, sheen can actually affect the performance of the paint. Use this guide to pick the right sheen for the job.

PAINT SHEEN BASICS:

FLAT/MATTE Requires fewer coats; best for slow-traffic areas, like ceilings and bedrooms.

SATIN/EGGSHELL A more durable sheen; ideal for high-traffic areas and small spaces.

SEMI-GLOSS/GLOSS More resistant to dirt and scuff marks, and easier to clean.

HI-GLOSS Incredibly durable, stain resistant, and easy to clean, but will highlight flaws.
